Conversation Starters

 - b. Where do you most need hope for the not yet, for the day when God makes all things new?
2. For now, there are multiple kingdoms in this world, competing against the kingdom of God. The Kingdom of Evil and The Kingdom of Self (where we live for ourselves) Romans 3:23 For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.
 - a. How will you put your focus on the Kingdom of God? Where can you look for the kingdom of God, places you normally overlook? Where have you grown too old to see the Kingdom of God in small, insignificant places?
3. In order to increase your joy in God’s promised eternal kingdom, make a list of 5-10 concrete things you look forward to experiencing and share your list with someone you trust.
