Small Group Questions:

- What is one of your favorite 'events' or experiences of church that you can recall? Have you had any disappointments with church?
- Read John 20:19-23. What do you notice? What do you think about Jesus' commissioning of his disciples? Do you live as a 'sent one'? And what does that mean to you?
- Read Luke 22:24-30 together. What really stands out to you?
- As you think about living a lifestyle of a servant, what is an area that challenges you? Or inspires you?
