

Psalm 19:1-4

The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands. Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they reveal knowledge. They have no speech, they use no words; no sound is heard from them. Yet their voice goes out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world.

Conversation Starters

- 1. Go outside for this discussion!
- 2. Have someone read Psalm 19:1 "For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities are clearly seen, being understood from what has been made." Where have you seen God's invisible qualities in creation? What are some of those qualities?
- 3. What is one moment in time outside that you would like to relive? Why?
- 4. Talk about the Spiritual Pathways Assessment with those who completed it: https://groupleaders.org/spiritual-pathways-assessment What did you learn? Were you surprised by anything?
- 5. In what environment do you best connect with God? Where and when do you feel closest to God?
- 6. Do you sense/feel/see God more clearly when you are outside? Describe a time when this was true for you.
- 7. What is one way this week that you might look for God or connect with God in the natural world?
- 8. Have you ever been drawn closer to God because of what you have seen in creation? Tell about this, how did it draw you closer?
