Icebreaker:

Small Group Questions:

- What practices or experiences have been most impactful to you on your faith journey?
- In your current/future family what are some practices you believe are important to foster faith development and character building in you and the next generation? Is there something different/new you would like to begin?
- In what ways can our influence/good intentions as parents be seen as control? And what ways can we positively influence and love the 'next generation' in the family of God?
- What is a parenting fail you remember? What role does grace play in faith development? Who might you need to forgive--yourself, your family??
