3. If you follow Jesus:
 - a. Where did you first get tattooed with God's love? Camp? Grandma and grandpa's house? Slowly over time? Etc.
 - b. What does that tattoo look like on you? What does it mean? How would you describe the way you have been marked by God's love?
4. Did it hurt? Why do you think Jeff made a comparison between asking someone if their tattoo hurt and being marked by Jesus?
