

**2 Cor. 2: 2-5** For I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except Jesus **Christ** and him **crucified.** I came to you in weakness with great fear and trembling. ## **Conversation Starters**

- 1. What is making you ask the question, "Is this real life", right now?
- **2.** How has your understanding of "Christ Crucified" evolved over your lifetime? What puzzles you about it? What inspires? What confuses?
- **3.** Can you think of a time when you witnessed or experienced, "weak is the new strong?" It could be in yourself or someone else?
- **4.** Do you share your weakness with God? If yes, why is that something you do? If not, what is keeping you from sharing your weakness with God?
- **5.** Karla said, "our weaknesses can actually make us more loveable." What do you think she means?
- 6. Sometimes weakness is the shadow side of a strength. For example people who are really good at self regulation can struggle with the up and down emotions that are unavoidable in a human life. Can you identify any of your strengths that taken to an extreme can tip into an area of weakness?
- Karla said, "Almost anything that can be accomplished with anger can be done better without." Discuss....
- **8.** How would you explain to a person who knew nothing about God, that weakness isn't an obstacle but an opening for God's power?
