  - a. What do you think or how do you feel about this clarification?

- 5. When you fall down, what factors lead you to stay down and what factors lead you to get back up?
- 6. If you are a follower of Jesus, how clear are you about why you follow Jesus today? What is your one sentence answer to this question? What holds you back from answering this question with confidence?
